Houseplants For Medium to Bright Light

Indoor gardeners tend to be divided into two groups: those who buy plants on impulse hoping that their purchase will survive, and those who buy plants with the plan to make them a permanent addition to their home. For both groups, the success of indoor houseplants is contingent on a few basic points. The most critical is location. Provide the kind of growing conditions your houseplant requires, considering light, size, and temperature. For bright rooms consider: Aloe vera, Aralia, Asparagus fern, Bird of Paradise, Bromeliad, Cactus, Croton, Dumb cane, Fig, Jade plant, Lipstick plant, Norfolk island pine, Palm, Pothos, Spider plant, ZZ plant, and many more!

Houseplants For Low to Medium Light

For areas of low to indirect light, there are also lots of choices. Consider Chinese evergreen (try the two new varieties called Silver Bay, and Stars!), Cast-iron plant, Schefflera, Grape ivy, Dracaena (green, red, yellow, & white variegated varieties!), Corn palm, Philodendron, Snake plant (also called Mother-in-Law's tongue!), Peace lily, and more!

Like landscaping outdoors, it is important to remember textures, shapes, and colours when grouping your houseplants. For example, a shorter plant with a wide red leaf (Croton) would look great in front of a tall of a green feathery plant (Palm).
