Hall's	6m	White changing to yellow, fragrant.	Sun/Shade	Twining	4
Harlequin	3m	Cream, pink and green leaves, pink/purple scented flowers.	Sun	Twining	4
John Clayton	8m	Clear yellow fragrant blooms. Long bloom season.	Sun/Shade	Twining	4

Flamenco	10m	Brilliant red flowers in summer.	Sun/Part Sun	Self-cling	4

Trumpet Vine (straight species)	8m	Yellow/orange flowers in August. Very vigorous.	Sun/Part Sun	Self-cling	4

<b>VIRGINIA CREEPER/BOSTON IVY</b>					
Boskoop Boston Ivy	8m	Fast growing. New growth is red; fall colour is crimson.	Sun/Shade	Self-cling	5
Boston Ivy	15m	Clings to even smooth surfaces. Scarlet in fall.	Sun/Shade	Self-cling	4
Engelman Ivy	10m	Dense, fast growing. Crimson in fall. Black fruit.	Sun/Shade	Self-cling	3
Virginia Creeper	12m	Rapid growth. Scarlet in fall.	Sun/Shade	Self-cling	3
Woodbine Ivy	12m	Dark green leaves. Blue/black fruit. Does not cling.	Sun/Shade	Twining	2
<b>WISTERIA</b>					
American – Amethyst Falls	8m	Fragrant, lavender-blue flowers hang in grape-like clusters. Not as profuse blooming as Asian types, but blooms more reliably.	Sun/Part Sun	Twining	6
Chinese (straight species)	10m	Lilac/blue flowers, can vary from plant to plant. Flower clusters are smaller, but more numerous than Japanese wisteria. Fragrant.	Sun	Twining	5
Chinese – Cooke's Purple	10m	Violet purple flowers clusters bloom in profusion. Vigorous.	Sun	Twining	5
Chinese – Prolific	10m	Abundant blue-violet flowers in spring. Highly fragrant.	Sun	Twining	5
Chinese - Texas White	10m	Pure white, fragrant blooms in spring. Larger flowers than 'Alba.'	Sun	Twining	5
Chinese – White	10m	White with faint hint of mauve. Very fragrant.	Sun	Twining	5
Japanese - Black Dragon	10m	Double dark purple. 12-20" long racemes.	Sun	Twining	5
Japanese - Issai	10m	Lilac-blue flowers on shorter racemes.	Sun	Twining	5
Japanese - Lawrence	6m	Blue and white; profuse blooming. Canadian introduction chosen for exceptional hardiness.	Sun	Twining	4
Japanese – Longissima Alba (Shiro Noda)	10m	Pure white flowers in 16" racemes. Very fragrant.	Sun	Twining	5
Japanese – Peaches and Cream	10m	White edged in pink. Prolific bloomers with light scent.	Sun	Twining	5
Japanese – Rosea (Pink Ice)	10m	Pure pink flowers on 12" racemes. Faintly scented.			
Kentucky - Aunt Dee	8m	Lilac. Smaller size and hardier than Asian wisterias.	Sun	Twining	4
Kentucky – Blue Moon	8m	Dark purple buds open to pale blue flowers. Very reliable bloomer; can actually rebloom in later summer.	Sun	Twining	4

American Bittersweet	10m	Full of orange-red berries in fall. Great for winter décor. Native.	Sun/Shade	Twining	2
American Bittersweet – Dianna	10m	Fruit-bearing female vine. Plant with ‘Hercules’ for pollination.	Sun/Shade	Twining	2
American Bittersweet – Hercules	10m	Fruitless male vine. Pollinizer for ‘Dianna.’	Sun/Shade	Twining	2
Baltic Ivy (English)	10m	Shiny, dark green leaves; changes to bronze, evergreen. Can be used as a groundcover.	Part Sun/Shade	Self-cling	5
Climbing Hydrangea	6m	Large white flower clusters in early summer, yellow fall colour.	Sun/Shade	Self-cling	4
Dutchman’s Pipe	9m	Heart shaped leaves. Brownish flowers shaped like pipes.	Sun/Shade	Twining	4
Japanese False Hydrangea	15m	Large white flowers, heart shaped leaves. Slow growing when young, faster once established. Shelter from afternoon sun.	Part Sun	Self-cling	5
Fiveleaf Akebia	8m	Incredibly fast growing vine with bluish leaves. Fragrant wine-red flowers in spring. Prune hard after flowering.	Sun/Part Sun	Twining	5
Hops - Golden	6m	Very fast growing vine with yellow-green leaves. Dies to the ground each year. Papery yellow fruit in fall.	Sun	Twining	3
Hops - Nugget	6m	Vigorous vine can grow 25’ per year. Papery yellow fruit in summer.	Sun/Shade	Twining	3
Issai Hardy Kiwi	8m	Rambling, self-fertile vine produces small fuzz-less edible kiwis in late summer. Eat like a grape, skin and all! Best fruit in full sun.	Sun/Part Sun	Twining	5
Porcelain Ivy	3m	A vigorous climber with showy purple-blue fruit in September.	Sun/Shade	Twining	5
Silverlace Vine	8m	Fast growing; fleecy white flowers in late summer.	Sun/Shade	Twining	5
